



Shine Dance Festival Studio Guide *for Dancers & Parents*

We are excited to welcome you to Shine Dance Festival and look forward to providing a fun, inspiring and organized weekend you are sure to remember! A few things to note:

- Dancers should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to, and be in costume and ready to perform 20 minutes prior to their scheduled performance time.
- Dancers should check in a minimum of 10 minutes before their scheduled performance time with the backstage manager in case we are running ahead of schedule.
- There is a rehearsal area available for warm up and practice. Please be considerate in sharing the space. When busy, each number should be run in order of performance no more than once.
- An area near the stage will be available for quick changes. A separate boys' change room will also be provided.
- Dancers should remain in costume for awards sessions and line up backstage a few numbers before each awards session.
- Our policy of no video or photography and no food or drink in the theatre will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply may result in disqualification. Professional photo & video will be available for purchase.
- Please allow adjudicators their privacy at all times to ensure a fair competition.
- Please remember to have cash on hand for parking, admission and souvenir items. Dancers performing in the festival and children 6 & under do not pay admission.
